RESOLVE

Directing the Board of Railroad Commissioners to investigate and report upon the Advisability of establishing a Uniform Passenger Rate of Two Cents a Mile upon the Railroads of the Commonwealth.

1 *Resolved*, That the board of railroad commissioners be
2 directed to investigate the practicability and advisability
3 of establishing in this Commonwealth a uniform rate not
4 exceeding two cents per mile for the carriage of passen-
5 gers by railroads; and to report their conclusions upon
6 the subject to the next General Court.
