RESOLUTIONS

Relative to the admission of Brigham H. Roberts of Utah to a Seat in the Fifty-sixth Congress of the United States.

1 *Resolved*, That the general court of Massachusetts de-
2 sires to enter its protest against the admission of Brig-
3 ham H. Roberts of Utah to a seat in the Congress of the
4 United States, to the end that the seal of condemnation
5 may be set against polygamy, the degradation of woman-
6 hood and the violation of all moral laws.

7 *Resolved*, That copies of these resolutions be trans-
8 mitted to the representatives from this Commonwealth in
9 the Fifty-sixth Congress as soon as that body shall have
10 convened.
