AN ACT

Making an Appropriation for Current Expenses at the Massachusetts Hospital for Dipsomaniacs and Inebriates.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The sum of twenty-five thousand
2 dollars is hereby appropriated, to be paid out of
3 the treasury of the Commonwealth, from the
4 ordinary revenue, to pay necessary expenses in
5 excess of any receipts at the Massachusetts hos-
6 pital for dipsomaniacs and inebriates at Fox-
7 borough, during the year ending on the thirty-
8 first day of December in the year eighteen hun-
9 dred and ninety-nine. [Acts 1889, chap. 414;

(Appropriation 1898, \$25,000.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
