RESOLVE

Granting a County Tax for the County of Franklin.

- 1 *Resolved*, That the following sums are hereby appro-
- 2 priated for the expenses of the county of Franklin for
- 3 the year eighteen hundred and ninety-nine.
- 4 For interest on county debt, a sum not exceeding
- 5 three thousand dollars.
- 6 For reduction of county debt, a sum not exceeding
- 7 fifteen thousand dollars.
- 8 For salaries of county officers and assistants, fixed by
- 9 law, a sum not exceeding six thousand three hundred
- 10 dollars.
- 11 For clerical assistance in county offices, a sum not
- 12 exceeding two thousand dollars.
- 13 For salaries and expenses of district and police courts,
- 14 a sum not exceeding six thousand dollars.
- 15 For salaries of jailers, masters and assistants, and
- 16 support of prisoners in jails and houses of correction, a
- 17 sum not exceeding seven thousand five hundred dollars.
- 18 For criminal costs in the superior court, a sum not
- 19 exceeding four thousand five hundred dollars.
- 20 For civil expenses in the supreme judicial and superior
- 21 courts, a sum not exceeding five thousand dollars.

22 For transportation expenses of county and special com-
23 missioners, a sum not exceeding five hundred dollars.

24 For medical examiners, inquests and commitments of
25 the insane, a sum not exceeding nine hundred dollars.

26 For auditors, masters and referees, a sum not exceed-
27 ing five hundred dollars.

28 For repairing, furnishing and improving county build-
29 ings, a sum not exceeding three thousand dollars.

30 For care, fuel, lights and supplies in county build-
31 ings, other than jails and houses of correction, a sum
32 not exceeding two thousand five hundred dollars.

33 For highways, bridges and land damages, a sum not
34 exceeding two thousand five hundred dollars.

35 For truant schools, a sum not exceeding three hun-
36 dred dollars.

37 For miscellaneous and contingent expenses of the
38 current year, a sum not exceeding one thousand three
39 hundred dollars.

40 And the county commissioners of said county are
41 hereby authorized to levy as the county tax of said
42 county for the current year, in the manner provided by
43 law, the sum of fifty-five thousand dollars, to be ex-
44 pended, together with the cash balance on hand and the
45 receipts from other sources, for the above purposes.
