RESOLVE

Granting a County Tax for the County of Barnstable.

- 1 *Resolved*, That the following sums are hereby appro-
- 2 priated for the expenses of the county of Barnstable for
- 3 the year eighteen hundred and ninety-nine.
- 4 For interest on county debt, a sum not exceeding
- 5 seven hundred dollars.
- 6 For reduction of county debt, a sum not exceeding
- 7 nine hundred dollars.
- 8 For salaries of county officers and assistants, fixed by
- 9 law, a sum not exceeding five thousand four hundred
- 10 and fifty dollars.
- 11 For clerical assistance in county offices, a sum not
- 12 exceeding one thousand dollars.
- 13 For salaries and expenses of district and police courts,
- 14 a sum not exceeding four thousand one hundred dollars.
- 15 For salaries of jailers, masters and assistants, and
- 16 support of prisoners in jails and houses of correction, a
- 17 sum not exceeding four thousand dollars.
- 18 For criminal costs in the superior court, a sum not
- 19 exceeding two thousand eight hundred dollars.
