RESOLVE.

Granting a County Tax for the County of Norfolk.

- 1 *Resolved*, That the following sums are hereby appro-
- 2 priated for the expenses of the county of Norfolk for
- 3 the year eighteen hundred and ninety-nine : —
- 4 For interest on county debt, a sum not exceeding five
- 5 thousand five hundred dollars.
- 6 For reduction of county debt, a sum not exceeding
- 7 fifteen thousand dollars.
- 8 For salaries of county officers and assistants, fixed by
- 9 law, a sum not exceeding sixteen thousand six hundred
- 10 dollars.
- 11 For clerical assistance in county offices, a sum not
- 12 exceeding eighteen thousand six hundred dollars.
- 13 For salaries and expenses of district and police courts,
- 14 a sum not exceeding twenty-three thousand dollars.
- 15 For salaries of jailers, masters and assistants, and
- 16 support of prisoners in jails and houses of correction, a
- 17 sum not exceeding twenty-five thousand dollars.
- 18 For criminal costs in the superior court, a sum not
- 19 exceeding eleven thousand dollars.
- 20 For civil expenses in the supreme judicial and supe-
- 21 rior courts, a sum not exceeding eleven thousand
- 22 dollars.

23 For transportation expenses of county and special
24 commissioners, a sum not exceeding three hundred
25 dollars.

26 For medical examiners, inquests, and commitments of
27 the insane, a sum not exceeding three thousand dollars.

28 For auditors, masters and referees, a sum not ex-
29 ceeding two thousand five hundred dollars.

30 For purchase of land for registry of deeds, a sum not
31 exceeding twenty thousand dollars.

32 For repairing, furnishing and improving county build-
33 ings, a sum not exceeding three thousand five hundred
34 dollars.

35 For care, fuel, lights and supplies in county buildings,
36 other than jails and houses of correction, a sum not ex-
37 ceeding eleven thousand dollars.

38 For highways, including state highways, bridges and
39 land damages, a sum not exceeding thirty thousand dol-
40 lars.

41 For truant schools, a sum not exceeding four hundred
42 dollars.

43 For miscellaneous and contingent expenses of the cur-
44 rent year, a sum not exceeding two thousand five hun-
45 dred dollars.

46 And the county commissioners of said county are
47 hereby authorized to levy as the county tax of said
48 county for the current year, in the manner provided by
49 law, the sum of one hundred and sixty thousand dol-
50 lars, to be expended, together with the cash balance on
51 hand and the receipts from other sources, for the above
52 purposes.
