AN ACT

Relative to the Construction of a Boulevard from the
Middlesex Fells Parkway to the Charles River.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The metropolitan park commission
2 is hereby authorized and instructed to make an
3 investigation as to the advisability of taking lands
4 for and constructing a road or boulevard from
5 Broadway park, Somerville, at the southerly end
6 of the Middlesex Fells parkway, or from any
7 other point in said parkway near the Mystic river,
8 to the Charles river at or near Cottage farm.
9 Said commission shall consider the various prac-
10 ticable routes and the cost of construction,
11 and shall report the result of its investigation,
12 together with its recommendations, to the next
13 general court. Any expense incurred under this
14 act shall be deducted from the unexpended balance
15 of the general appropriation for metropolitan
16 boulevards.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
