AN ACT

Relative to the Time for holding Municipal Elections
in the City of Boston.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The annual election of municipal
2 officers in the city of Boston shall be held on the
3 Tuesday next after the first Monday in November.

1 SECTION 2. All acts and parts of acts incon-
2 sistent herewith are hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall be submitted to the
2 voters of Boston at the annual election in the
3 year eighteen hundred and ninety-nine, and, if
4 accepted by a majority of the voters voting at
5 such election, it shall take effect in the year nine-
6 teen hundred; otherwise it shall be null and void.
