In Favor of Norman Y. Brintnall.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the  
2 treasury of the Commonwealth to Norman Y. Brintnall  
3 of Boston the sum of one hundred dollars in full com-  
4 pensation for all claims on account of a horse owned by  
5 him which, while in use on hire by the state militia,  
6 became overheated and died.
