### AN ACT

To provide for the construction of a Highway and Sidewalk over Land of the Commonwealth at the State Muster-field in the Town of Framingham.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The state highway commission of  
2 this Commonwealth is hereby authorized and di-  
3 rected to construct a highway on that portion of  
4 the land of the Commonwealth outside of and  
5 parallel to the fence enclosing the muster-field of  
6 the Commonwealth and parallel to Concord street,  
7 in the town of Framingham; also, construct a  
8 sidewalk from the point where the sidewalk of  
9 the town of Framingham terminates to the main  
10 or Concord street entrance to the muster-field,  
11 the cost of the same to be assumed and paid by  
12 the Commonwealth and the town of Framingham  
13 in the proportion of two-thirds by the former and  
14 one-third by the latter, the amount paid by the

15 Commonwealth to be taken from the appropria-  
16 tion for the state highway commission for the year  
17 eighteen hundred and ninety-nine. The total ex-  
18 pense for the construction of said highway and  
19 sidewalk shall not exceed the sum of five thou-  
20 sand dollars.

1 SECTION 2. The town of Framingham shall  
2 maintain and keep in repair said highway and  
3 sidewalk as a part of its own highways and side-  
4 walks as long as they are so used.

1 SECTION 3. No part of this work shall be be-  
2 gun until the town of Framingham, in town meet-  
3 ing called for the purpose, shall accept the  
4 conditions named in sections one and two of this  
5 act.

1 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
