AN ACT

To confirm the Acts of Certain Towns at their Annual Meetings, in the year Eighteen Hundred and Ninety-nine.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The several acts of the towns of
2 Becket, Huntington, Middlefield, Southwick and
3 Sutton at their annual meetings, in the year eigh-
4 teen hundred and ninety-nine are hereby con-
5 firmed and made valid.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
