

HOUSE No. 1156.

[Bill accompanying the petition of Leonard W. Ross. Water Supply.]

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-nine.

AN ACT

To authorize the Water Commissioners of Canton to supply Knollwood Cemetery with Water.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The water commissioners of the
2 town of Canton, in addition to the powers con-
3 ferred upon them by chapter ninety-five of the
4 acts of the year eighteen hundred and eighty-
5 five, are hereby authorized to supply Knollwood
6 cemetery in the town of Sharon with water, upon
7 such terms as the parties may agree upon.

1 SECTION 2. For the said purpose, the said
2 water commissioners may enter upon and dig up,

3 as may be necessary, any lands or ways, public
4 or private, in either of said towns, and may lay
5 down and construct such pipes, conduits and
6 water works in general as may be necessary.
7 The lands or ways so entered upon or dug up
8 shall be occupied and obstructed no more and no
9 longer than is absolutely necessary, and they shall
10 be restored by the said commissioners, to the
11 satisfaction of the selectmen of the town in which
12 they are situated, to their original condition.

1 SECTION 3. Any permanent damage to prop-
2 erty occasioned by any act done in accordance
3 herewith shall be assessed and paid by the said
4 water commissioners ; and if any person is ag-
5 grieved by such assessment, he may have the
6 same remedies allowed by law in cases where
7 land is taken for highways.

1 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
