Resolve accompanying the petition of Clarence A. Warren for legislation to provide for an investigation relative to the construction of a boulevard or parkway to connect the Revere Beach parkway at Revere beach with the shore drive in the town of Winthrop. Metropolitan Affairs. January 8.

RESOLVE

To provide for an Investigation by the Metropolitan Park Commission of the Expense of connecting the Parkway at Revere Beach with the Shore Drive in the Town of Winthrop.

1 *Resolved*, That the metropolitan park commission be
2 and hereby is authorized to investigate the probable
3 expense of constructing a boulevard or parkway to con-
4 nect the parkway at Revere Beach with the Shore Drive,
5 so called, in the town of Winthrop, and whether the public
6 interest requires the construction of such boulevard or
7 parkway, said estimate and report to include the cost of
8 land necessary to be taken for the purpose. The com-
9 mission shall report the result of the investigation to
10 the next general court, not later than the second Monday
11 in January.
