AN ACT

Making Appropriations for the Expenses of the Board of Free Public Library Commissioners.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned are
2 appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury of the
3 commonwealth, from the ordinary revenue, for the
4 purposes specified, for the fiscal year ending on the
5 thirtieth day of November, nineteen hundred and
6 nine, to wit:—

7 To carry out the provisions of the act to promote
8 the establishment and efficiency of free public
9 libraries, a sum not exceeding two thousand dollars.
10 (Rev. Laws, ch. 38, sect. 11; Acts 1906, ch. 183.)

(Appropriation 1908, \$2,000.)

11 For clerical assistance to and incidental and nec-
12 essary expenses of the board of free public library
13 commissioners, the same to include printing and
14 binding the annual report, a sum not exceeding
15 seven hundred dollars. (Rev. Laws, chs. 9 and 11;
16 Acts 1902, ch. 438; 1906, ch. 183.)

(Appropriation 1908, \$700.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
