Bill accompanying the petition of Charles C. Spellman, chairman, for legislation to authorize the county commissioners of the county of Hampden to borrow money for the purpose of repairing and enlarging the court house in the city of Springfield. Counties. January 14.

AN ACT

To provide for Better Accommodations for the Courts, Law Library and County Offices of the County of Hampden.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The county commissioners of the county
2 of Hampden are hereby authorized and empowered to
3 make necessary repairs, alterations and additions to the
4 court house building in Springfield to provide suitable
5 and sufficient accommodations for the courts, the law li-
6 brary and public offices of the county, and may expend
7 for this purpose a sum not exceeding two hundred thou-
8 sand dollars. Said building when completed shall be
9 as nearly fire proof as possible.

1 SECTION 2. To meet the expenses incurred under this
 2 act said commissioners may borrow from time to time
 3 upon the credit of said county a sum not exceeding in
 4 the aggregate two hundred thousand dollars.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its pas-
 2 sage.
