AN ACT

Relative to the Display of the National and State Flags
on State Buildings.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 The flag of the United States and the flag
2 of the commonwealth shall be displayed on the
3 main or administration building of each of the pub-
4 lic institutions of the commonwealth. The flags
5 shall be of suitable dimensions and be flown every
6 day when the weather permits. The expense of
7 such flags and of the necessary means for their
8 display shall be paid from the appropriations for
9 the several institutions.
