Resolve accompanying the petition of J. Lewis Ellsworth, secretary, for legislation to provide for certain equipment, repairs and improvements and for the purchase of land and erection of buildings at the Massachusetts Agricultural College. Agriculture. January 18.

RESOLVE

To provide for Certain Equipment, Repairs, and Improvements and for the Purchase of Land and the Erection of Buildings at the Massachusetts Agricultural College.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 treasury of the commonwealth a sum not exceeding one
3 hundred seventy-one thousand one hundred and five dol-
4 lars, to be expended at the Massachusetts agricultural
5 college under the direction of the trustees thereof, for
6 the following purposes:— for teaching and office equip-
7 ment in the various departments of the college, a sum not
8 exceeding thirteen thousand six hundred and five dollars;
9 for repairs and improvements to buildings and other col-
10 lege property, including the extension of the heating
11 plant, a sum not exceeding forty thousand dollars; for
12 the purchase of land to be used for an athletic field and

13 for other college purposes, a sum not exceeding fifteen
14 thousand dollars; for the erection of a fire proof building
15 for the departments of zoology and entomology, a sum
16 not exceeding eighty thousand dollars; for the erection
17 of a farm house, a sum not exceeding two thousand five
18 hundred dollars; for the erection of a fruit storage house,
19 a sum not exceeding three thousand dollars; for the erec-
20 tion of buildings for instruction in poultry husbandry,
21 a sum not exceeding three thousand dollars; for the erec-
22 tion of a stock judging pavilion, a sum not exceeding
23 eight thousand dollars; for the erection of a house for
24 the head of the division of horticulture, a sum not ex-
25 ceeding six thousand dollars.
