Bill accompanying the petition of David A. Ellis, chairman, for legislation to extend the authority of the school committee of the city of Boston over organizations of school pupils. Education. January 18.

AN ACT

Relative to the Authority of the School Committee of the City of Boston over Organizations of School Pupils.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The school committee of the city of
2 Boston may prescribe such conditions governing the
3 admission of pupils enrolled in the public schools of
4 said city to organizations composed wholly or in part
5 of public school pupils, and their continuance therein,
6 as it may deem desirable for the welfare of the public
7 schools, and may exclude from the public schools any
8 pupil not required by law to attend school who neglects
9 or refuses to comply with any regulation established by
10 said committee, in accordance with the provisions of
11 this act.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
