Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Nine.

AN ACT

To provide that all Vehicles on Highways shall carry Lights at Night.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Every vehicle propelled or drawn by
2 muscular power on any highway shall be provided dur-
3 ing the period from one hour after sunset to one hour
4 before sunrise with a light or lights at such place or
5 places on the said vehicle and of such size and visible at
6 such distance as shall be prescribed by the highway com-
7 mission.

1 SECTION 2. The highway commission shall prescribe
2 the place or places and the size of the light or lights
3 named in section one of this act.

1 SECTION 3. Any person violating the provisions of
2 this act shall be subject to a fine not exceeding twenty
3 dollars.
