AN ACT

Relative to the Sale of Intoxicating Liquors in Hotels
in No-License Cities and Towns.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 All hotels within this commonwealth containing
2 thirty or more rooms, in cities and towns where no
3 license has been voted, shall be permitted to sell in-
4 toxicating liquors to registered guests, but not at an
5 open bar, which is hereby prohibited. Licenses to
6 the proprietors of said hotels shall be granted by
7 and subject to the same authority as licenses which
8 are granted in cities and towns where licenses have
9 been voted.
