## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Nine.

### AN ACT

Making Appropriations for Salaries and Expenses in the Department of the Adjutant-General, and for Sundry Military Expenses.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned are  
2 appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury of the  
3 commonwealth, from the ordinary revenue, for the  
4 purposes specified, for the fiscal year ending on  
5 the thirtieth day of November, nineteen hundred  
6 and nine.

7 For the salary of the adjutant-general, thirty-  
8 six hundred dollars. (Acts 1908, ch. 604.)

(Appropriation 1908, \$3,600.)

9 For the salaries of the four clerks in the adju-  
10 tant-general's department, seven thousand dollars.  
11 (Acts 1908, ch. 604.)

(Appropriation 1908, \$7,000.)

12 For the salary of the messenger in the adjutant-  
13 general's department, eight hundred dollars.  
14 (Acts 1908, ch. 604.)

(Appropriation 1908, \$800.)

15 For such additional clerical assistance as the ad-  
16 jutant-general may find necessary, a sum not ex-  
17 ceeding six thousand dollars. (Acts 1908, ch. 604.)

(Appropriation 1908, \$6,000.)

18 For incidental and contingent office expenses in  
19 the adjutant-general's department, including print-  
20 ing and binding the annual report, a sum not ex-  
21 ceeding five thousand dollars. (Acts 1908, ch.  
22 604.)

(Appropriation 1908, \$5,000.)

23 For expenses in connection with military ac-  
24 counts not otherwise provided for, a sum not ex-  
25 ceeding four thousand dollars. (Acts 1908, ch.  
26 604.)

(Appropriation 1908, \$4,000.)

27 For compensation of officers and men of the  
28 volunteer militia, a sum not exceeding one hundred  
29 and sixty- thousand dollars. (Acts 1908, ch.  
30 604.)

(Appropriation 1908, \$165,000.)

31 For the transportation of officers and men of the  
32 volunteer militia, when on military duty, a sum not  
33 exceeding twenty-five thousand dollars. (Acts  
34 1908, ch. 604.)

(Appropriation 1908, \$25,000.)

35 For an allowance to commissioned officers of the  
36 militia towards the purchase of uniforms, a sum  
37 not exceeding eighteen thousand one hundred and  
38 sixty-five dollars. (Acts 1908, ch. 604.)

(Appropriation 1908, \$17,710.)

39 For allowance to officers of the militia for the  
40 care and responsibility of property, a sum not ex-  
41 ceeding six thousand and fifty dollars. (Acts 1908,  
42 ch. 604.)

(Appropriation 1908, \$5,450.)

43 For allowance and repairs of clothing of the  
44 volunteer militia, a sum not exceeding thirteen  
45 thousand three hundred and twenty-four dollars.  
46 (Acts 1908, ch. 604.)

(Appropriation 1908, \$13,132.)

47 For allowance to headquarters and companies,  
48 a sum not exceeding thirty-eight hundred dollars.  
49 (Acts 1908, ch. 604.)

(Appropriation 1908, \$3,790.)

50 For services of company armorers, a sum not  
51 exceeding twelve thousand three hundred and  
52 seventy-five dollars. (Acts 1905, ch. 604.)

(Appropriation 1908, \$12,000.)

53 For giving instruction in riding to non-commis-  
54 sioned officers and others who are required by law  
55 to be mounted, a sum not exceeding fifty-three hun-  
56 dred and twenty-dollars. (Acts 1908, ch. 604.)

(Appropriation 1908, \$3,920.)

57 For furnishing the officers and men of the or-  
58 ganized militia with uniform instruction in military  
59 authority, organization and administration and in  
60 the elements of military art, a sum not exceeding  
61 four thousand dollars. (Acts 1908, ch. 317 and  
62 604.)

(Appropriation 1908, \$4000.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
