AN ACT

Relative to the authority of Receivers of the Estates of Absentees.

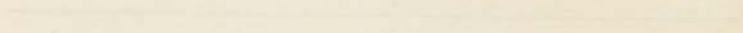
Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The probate court may authorize the re-
2 ceiver of the property or estate of an absentee, appointed
3 in accordance with the provisions of chapter one hundred
4 and forty-four of the Revised Laws and amendments
5 thereto, to adjust by arbitration or compromise any de-
6 mand in favor of or against the estate of such absentee.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
