Bill accompanying the petition of Hugh H. O'Rourke for legislation relative to the compensation of the members of the Board of Railroad Commissioners. Public Service. January 21.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Nine.

AN ACT

Relative to the Compensation of the Members of the Board of Railroad Commissioners.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. That salaries and expenses of the mem-
2 bers of the board of railroad commissioners shall here-
3 after be paid by the commonwealth out of the state
4 treasury, and the said railroad commissioners and any
5 employee or agent of the said board shall receive no
6 entertainment or reward from any railroad or railway
7 corporation within the commonwealth.

1 SECTION 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent
2 herewith are hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
