

Bill accompanying the petition of G. A. Hibbard, mayor of the city of Boston, for further legislation relative to the expenses of the county of Suffolk. January 22.

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Nine.

AN ACT

Relative to the Maintenance of County Buildings in the County of Suffolk.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section five of chapter twenty of the
2 Revised Laws is hereby amended by striking out in the
3 second line thereof after the word "county", the words
4 "except Suffolk," so that said section when amended
5 shall read as follows: — *Section 5.* Each county shall
6 provide suitable court houses, jails, houses of correction,
7 fire proof offices and other necessary public buildings
8 for the use of the county; but the county of Dukes
9 county need not provide a house of correction.

1 SECTION 2. Chapter twenty of the Revised Laws is
2 hereby further amended by striking out therefrom sec-
3 tions seven and eight.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its pas-
2 sage.
