Bill accompanying the petition of William B. Willeutt for legislation relative to the appointment and terms of probation officers in the county of Suffolk. Legal Affairs. January 22.

AN ACT

Relative to the Appointment of Probation Officers in the Superior Court for the County of Suffolk.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Probation officers for the superior court
2 in the county of Suffolk shall hereafter be appointed by
3 the justices of said court, for the term of three years.
4 Such appointments shall be made within one month after
5 the passage of this act, and said appointments shall
6 hereafter be made for the term of three years.

1 SECTION 2. The probation officers now serving in
2 said court shall cease to hold their positions upon the
3 appointment under this act of their successors.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
