Bill accompanying the petition of William H. Brigham for legislation relative to certain land adjoining the armory in the city of Springfield. Military Affairs. January 25.

AN ACT

Relative to the Disposition of Land adjoining the Armory
in the City of Springfield.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The governor of the commonwealth is
2 hereby authorized to execute deeds or other necessary
3 instruments granting a right of way in the piece of vacant
4 land adjoining the armory in the city of Springfield, ex-
5 tending from Howard street to the rear end of the armory
6 lot, and belonging to the commonwealth, to the owners
7 or occupants of the strip of land adjoining the same, on
8 condition that a similar right of way is granted to the
9 commonwealth in the said adjoining strip.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
