AN ACT

Relative to the Business of Making Small Loans.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section six of chapter six hundred and five of the
2 acts of the year nineteen hundred and eight is hereby
3 amended by inserting in the first line of said section the
4 word "and", and by striking out in the third and fourth
5 lines of said section the following words:— and loan
6 companies and loan associations established by special
7 charter and placed under said provision,— so that
8 the section as amended will read as follows:— *Sec-*
9 *tion 6.* National banks and all bank institutions which
10 are under the supervision of the bank commissioner
11 shall be exempt from the provisions of this act.
