

HOUSE No. 825

Bill accompanying the petition of Benjamin F. Badger for further legislation relative to the sale of intoxicating liquors on the Lord's day. The Liquor Law. January 26.

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Nine.

AN ACT

To prohibit the Sale of Intoxicating Liquors on the Lord's Day.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The sale of spirituous or intoxicating
2 liquors on the Lord's day in cities and towns which vote
3 to authorize the granting of licenses for the sale of in-
4 toxicating liquors of the first, second, third, fourth and
5 fifth classes is hereby forbidden.

1 SECTION 2. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent
2 herewith are hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect on the first day
2 of January, nineteen hundred and ten.
