### AN ACT

To authorize the Granting of Licenses to Innholders to Sell Intoxicating Liquors in No-license Cities and Towns.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. In any city or town which has voted not  
2 to grant licenses for the sale of intoxicating liquors at  
3 its annual election, the licensing board or the select-  
4 men may grant licenses subject to the terms and restric-  
5 tions contained in chapters one hundred and one hundred  
6 and two of the Revised Laws and amendments thereto,  
7 to innholders in such locations as in their judgment will  
8 not be detrimental to the public welfare, to sell intoxi-  
9 cating liquor to be drunk on the premises to bona fide

10 registered guests, who have resorted to his or their  
11 hotels for food or lodging. Such licensees shall not  
12 sell, give away or serve intoxicating liquor to any resi-  
13 dent of the city or town in which his hotel is situated.  
14 The fee for this license shall not be less than one thou-  
15 sand dollars. Such license shall expire on the thirtieth  
16 day of April following the date of the issue hereof.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
