Bill accompanying the petition of Thomas Pattison for legislation relative to the protection of seed scallops. Fisheries and Game. January 27.

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Nine.

AN ACT

Relative to the Protection of Seed Scallops.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. No person shall take or have in his pos-
2 session more than fifteen per cent of unculled or seed
3 scallops. All over fifteen per cent of the catch taken
4 from the flats or tide waters of the commonwealth shall
5 be returned alive and uninjured to tide water.

1 SECTION 2. It shall be lawful for any person to take
2 any scallops, at any time, from the shore, above low
3 water mark.

1 SECTION 3. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent
2 herewith are hereby repealed.
