## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

### AN ACT

To require Monthly Accounts from Administrators, Executors, Trustees under Wills, Guardians, Conservators and Receivers in Certain Instances.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Every administrator, executor, trustee  
2 under will, guardian, conservator and receiver, where  
3 the inventory of the estate entrusted to him for manage-  
4 ment or control exceeds five hundred dollars, shall file  
5 monthly accounts on the first or second day of each  
6 month, making a full and complete statement of the  
7 condition of the estate which he manages.

1 SECTION 2. Failure to comply with this act will be  
2 grounds for his removal from office.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its pas-  
2 sage.
