Bill accompanying the petition of Pierce J. Grace and others for legislation to provide for the discontinuance of the elevated structure on Washington street and the extension of the Washington street tunnel to Dudley street in the city of Boston. Metropolitan Affairs. January 27.

AN ACT

To provide for the Extension of the Washington Street Tunnel in the City of Boston.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The present Washington street tunnel
2 used by the elevated railroad in the city of Boston shall
3 be extended by the Boston transit commission, or such
4 other board or authority as shall be charged with such
5 construction, to a point beyond Dudley street, under the
6 same provisions as to construction, payment and use as
7 provided by law for the construction, payment and use
8 of the said present tunnel.

1 SECTION 2. The elevated structure now in said Wash-
2 ington and connecting streets used in connection with
3 the present tunnel, shall on the construction of the ex-
4 tension of the tunnel hereinbefore provided for, be
5 removed, the expenses thereof to be considered a part
6 of the cost of construction of said extension.
