Bill accompanying the petition of J. M. Hefferon for legislation relative to the number of freight cars operated as one train and to the number of men employed on such trains. Railroads. January 27.

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Nine.

AN ACT

Relative to the Number of Men who shall operate Freight Trains in this Commonwealth.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful to operate on any
2 railroad or part thereof owned, leased, operated or con-
3 trolled by a railroad corporation doing business in this
4 commonwealth a freight train of twenty or more cars
5 unless the same is manned by the following crew, viz. :
6 one engineer, one fireman, one conductor, one flagman
7 and two brakemen.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
