### AN ACT

To amend the Law prohibiting Unauthorized Persons from riding upon a Railroad or upon the Property of the Boston Terminal Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter two hundred and eight of the acts of the  
2 year nineteen hundred and five to prohibit unauthor-  
3 ized persons from riding upon a railroad or upon the  
4 property of the Boston Terminal Company is hereby  
5 amended by striking out, in lines five, six and seven,  
6 the words, "after being requested to leave the same  
7 by an employee of the railroad or of said Boston Ter-  
8 minal Company, or by a police officer". — so that the

9 chapter as amended shall read as follows:— Whoever,  
10 without right, rides or attempts to ride upon a loco-  
11 tive engine, tender, freight car, caboose, or other con-  
12 veyance not a part of a passenger train, upon a railroad  
13 or upon the property of the Boston Terminal Company  
14 shall be punished by a fine of not more than fifty dollars  
15 or imprisonment for not more than six months. A  
16 sheriff, deputy sheriff, constable, police officer, railroad  
17 police officer or officer appointed with the powers of a  
18 railroad police officer, upon view of such an offence, may,  
19 without warrant, arrest the offender and make complaint  
20 against him therefor.
