AN ACT

Making Appropriations for Salaries and Expenses in the Office of the Insurance Commissioner.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned are
2 appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury of the
3 commonwealth, from the ordinary revenue, for the
4 purposes specified, for the fiscal year ending on
5 the thirtieth day of November, nineteen hundred
6 and nine, to wit:—

7 For the salary of the insurance commissioner,
8 five thousand dollars. (Acts 1907, ch. 576.)

(Appropriation 1908, \$5,000.)

9 For the salary of the deputy insurance commis-
10 sioner, thirty-five hundred dollars. (Acts 1907,
11 ch. 576.)

(Appropriation 1908, \$3,500.)

12 For the salary of the examiner in the insurance
13 department, three thousand dollars. (Acts 1907,
14 ch. 576.)

(Appropriation 1908, \$3,000.)

15 For the salary of the actuary in the insurance
16 department, two thousand dollars. (Acts 1907,
17 ch. 576.)

(Appropriation 1908, \$2,000.)

18 For the salary of the chief clerk in the insurance
19 department, two thousand dollars. (Acts 1907,
20 ch. 576.)

(Appropriation 1908, \$2,000.)

21 For the salary of the second clerk in the insur-
22 ance department, fifteen hundred dollars. (Acts
23 1907, ch. 576.)

(No appropriation in 1908.)

24 For the salary of the third clerk in the insurance
25 department, twelve hundred dollars. (Acts 1907,
26 ch. 576.)

(Appropriation 1908, \$1,200.)

27 For such additional clerks and assistants as the
28 insurance commissioner may find necessary for the
29 despatch of public business, a sum not exceeding
30 thirty-seven thousand five hundred dollars. (Acts
31 1907, ch. 576.)

(Appropriation 1908, \$35,850.)

32 For incidental and contingent expenses of the
33 insurance commissioner, a sum not exceeding eleven
34 thousand dollars. (Acts 1907, ch. 576.)

(Appropriation 1908, \$13,000.)

35 For printing and binding the annual report of the
36 insurance commissioner, a sum not exceeding fifty-
37 eight hundred dollars. (Rev. Laws, ch. 9, sect. 7;
38 Acts 1902, ch. 438; 1907, ch. 576.)

(Appropriation 1908, \$5,800.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
