AN ACT

Making Appropriations for the Maintenance of the
Massachusetts School for the Feeble-Minded.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned are
2 appropriated, to be paid for the maintenance of the
3 Massachusetts School for the Feeble-Minded during
4 the fiscal year ending on the thirtieth day of No-
5 vember, nineteen hundred and nine, to wit:—

6 From the receipts of said school now in the treas-
7 ury of the commonwealth, the sum of ninety-six
8 thousand five hundred twenty-seven dollars and
9 seventy-one cents; and from the treasury of the
10 commonwealth from the ordinary revenue, a sum in
11 addition not exceeding one hundred sixty-eight thou-
12 sand four hundred seventy-two dollars and twenty-
13 nine cents. (Acts 1905, chaps. 175 and 211.)

(Appropriation 1908, \$118,114.96.)

14 For the city of Waltham for the annual assess-
15 ment due from the commonwealth towards main-
16 taining and operating a system of sewage disposal

17 at the Massachusetts School for the Feeble-Minded,
18 the sum of eight hundred and twenty dollars and
19 eighty-nine cents, as provided for in section three of
20 chapter eighty-three of the acts of the year eighteen
21 hundred and ninety-three.

(Appropriation 1908, \$820.89.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
