RESOLVE

To provide for New Boilers at the State House.

- 1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
- 2 treasury of the commonwealth, from the ordinary rev-
- 3 enue, a sum not exceeding twelve thousand dollars, to
- 4 be expended under the direction of the governor and
- 5 council, for the purpose of installing two new boilers in
- 6 the State House.
