AN ACT

To authorize the Removal of Remains from a Disused
Graveyard in the Town of Revere.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The selectmen of the town of Revere
2 are hereby authorized, at the expense of the town,
3 to remove the human remains in certain private
4 tombs in a graveyard in the rear of the lot occupied
5 by the Unitarian church in said town, and to cause
6 the same to be carefully and properly buried in
7 some suitable cemetery. The graves so filled shall
8 be suitably marked with the names of the persons
9 buried if they are known.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
