RESOLVE

Granting a County Tax for the County of Middlesex.

- 1 *Resolved*, That the following sums are hereby appro-
- 2 priated for the expenses of the county of Middlesex for
- 3 the year nineteen hundred and nine:—
- 4 For interest on county debt, a sum not exceeding
- 5 thirty-five thousand dollars.
- 6 For reduction of county debt, a sum not exceeding
- 7 forty-five thousand dollars.
- 8 For salaries of county officers and assistants, fixed by
- 9 law, a sum not exceeding thirty-nine thousand dollars.
- 10 For clerical assistance in county offices, a sum not ex-
- 11 ceeding seventy-two thousand dollars.
- 12 For salaries and expenses of district and police courts,
- 13 a sum not exceeding ninety-five thousand dollars.
- 14 For salaries of jailers, masters and assistants, and sup-
- 15 port of prisoners in jails and houses of correction, a sum
- 16 not exceeding one hundred and fifty-eight thousand
- 17 dollars.
- 18 For criminal costs in the superior court, a sum not
- 19 exceeding fifty-eight thousand dollars.
- 20 For civil expenses in the supreme judicial and superior
- 21 courts, a sum not exceeding eighty thousand dollars.

22 For trial justices, a sum not exceeding three thousand
23 five hundred dollars.

24 For transportation expenses of county and associate
25 commissioners, a sum not exceeding six hundred dollars.

26 For medical examiners, inquests, and commitments of
27 the insane, a sum not exceeding sixteen thousand dollars.

28 For auditors, masters and referees, a sum not exceed-
29 ing ten thousand dollars.

30 For repairing, furnishing and improving county build-
31 ings, a sum not exceeding forty thousand dollars.

32 For fuel, lights and supplies in county buildings, other
33 than jails and houses of correction, and for care of the
34 same, a sum not exceeding sixty thousand dollars.

35 For highways, including state highways, bridges and
36 land damages, a sum not exceeding fifty-three thousand
37 dollars.

38 For law libraries, a sum not exceeding seven thousand
39 dollars.

40 For truant schools, a sum not exceeding thirty-two
41 thousand dollars.

42 For miscellaneous and contingent expenses of the cur-
43 rent year, a sum not exceeding six thousand five hundred
44 dollars.

45 And the county commissioners of said county are
46 hereby authorized to levy as the county tax of said county
47 for the current year, in the manner provided by law, the
48 sum of six hundred and seventy-two thousand two hun-
49 dred sixty-one dollars and nineteen cents, to be expended,
50 together with the cash balance on hand and the receipts
51 from other sources, for the above purposes.
