RESOLVE

Granting a County Tax for the County of Hampden.

- 1 *Resolved*, That the following sums are hereby appro-
2 priated for the expenses of the county of Hampden for the
3 year nineteen hundred and nine: —
4 For interest on county debt, a sum not exceeding twelve
5 thousand dollars.
6 For reduction of county debt, a sum not exceeding
7 twenty thousand dollars.
8 For salaries of county officers and assistants, fixed by
9 law, a sum not exceeding eighteen thousand dollars.
10 For clerical assistance in county offices, a sum not ex-
11 ceeding ten thousand dollars.
12 For salaries and expenses of district and police courts,
13 a sum not exceeding twenty-six thousand dollars.
14 For salaries of jailers, masters and assistants, and sup-
15 port of prisoners in jails and houses of correction, a sum
16 not exceeding thirty-five thousand dollars.
17 For criminal costs in the superior court, a sum not ex-
18 ceeding ten thousand dollars.
19 For civil expenses in the supreme judicial and superior
20 courts, a sum not exceeding fifteen thousand dollars.

21 For trial justices, a sum not exceeding five hundred
22 dollars.

23 For transportation expenses of county and associate
24 commissioners, a sum not exceeding five hundred dollars.

25 For medical examiners, inquests, and commitments of
26 the insane, a sum not exceeding six thousand dollars.

27 For auditors, masters and referees, a sum not exceed-
28 ing four thousand dollars.

29 For building county buildings, a sum not exceeding six
30 thousand dollars.

31 For repairing, furnishing and improving county build-
32 ings, a sum not exceeding twenty-five thousand dollars.

33 For fuel, lights and supplies in county buildings, other
34 than jails and houses of correction, and for care of the
35 same, a sum not exceeding thirteen thousand dollars.

36 For highways, including state highways, bridges and
37 land damages, a sum not exceeding ten thousand dollars.

38 For law libraries, a sum not exceeding two thousand
39 five hundred dollars.

40 For truant schools, a sum not exceeding seven thousand
41 dollars.

42 For miscellaneous and contingent expenses of the cur-
43 rent year, a sum not exceeding seven thousand five hun-
44 dred thirty-five dollars and nineteen cents.

45 For the care and maintenance of the Mount Tom state
46 reservation, a sum not exceeding four thousand two hun-
47 dred dollars.

48 And the county commissioners of said county are
49 hereby authorized to levy as the county tax of said county
50 for the current year, in the manner provided by law, the
51 sum of one hundred and eighty-four thousand dollars, to
52 be expended, together with the cash balance on hand and
53 the receipts from other sources, for the above purposes.
