Bill accompanying the petition of Arthur W. Paine and others, selectmen, for legislation to authorize the town of Holbrook to make an additional water loan. Water Supply. April 26.

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Nine.

AN ACT

To authorize the Town of Holbrook to make an Additional Water Loan.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The town of Holbrook, for the purposes
2 mentioned in chapter two hundred and seventeen of the
3 acts of the year eighteen hundred and eighty-five, may
4 issue bonds, notes or scrip from time to time, to be denom-
5 inated on the face thereof, Holbrook Water Loan, to an
6 amount not exceeding four thousand dollars in addition to
7 the amount heretofore authorized by law to be issued by
8 said town for the same purposes. Such bonds, notes or
9 scrip shall be issued upon the terms and conditions and
10 with the powers specified in said chapter for the use of

11 the Holbrook water loan: *provided*, that the whole amount
 12 of bonds, notes or scrip issued under the authority of this
 13 act, and heretofore issued by said town for the same
 14 purposes, shall not exceed one hundred and forty-four
 15 thousand dollars.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
