### RESOLVE

To provide for Certain Improvements at the State Hospital.

1     *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the  
2 treasury of the commonwealth, to be expended at the  
3 state hospital at Tewksbury, under the direction of the  
4 trustees thereof, a sum not exceeding forty-five thousand  
5 dollars, for the following purposes: For the enlargement  
6 of the laundry, a sum not exceeding eight thousand  
7 dollars; for the enlargement of the filter bed, a sum not  
8 exceeding two thousand dollars, and for additions to  
9 the heating and lighting plant, and for furnishing cer-  
10 tain new buildings, a sum not exceeding thirty-five  
11 thousand dollars.
