In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Nine.

### RESOLVE

To provide for Certain Improvements at the Massachusetts  
Hospital for Epileptics.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the  
2 treasury of the commonwealth a sum not exceeding five  
3 thousand dollars, to be expended at the Massachusetts  
4 hospital for epileptics, under the direction of the  
5 trustees thereof, for the purpose of making sewer, water  
6 and electric connections between the new building and  
7 the central plant.
