RESOLVE

To provide for an Investigation as to the Desirability of authorizing the Boston and Eastern Electric Railroad Company to construct a Tunnel and Subways in the City of Boston.

1 *Resolved*, That the board of railroad commissioners
2 and the Boston transit commission, sitting jointly, be
3 requested to investigate and report to the general court
4 on or before the second Saturday of January, nineteen
5 hundred and ten, whether or not, in their opinion, it
6 is advisable, expedient and in the public interest to
7 grant the following petition for legislation, namely:
8 petition of Melville Woodbury and others with accom-
9 panying bill, House, number ten hundred and ninety-
10 four, and under what conditions and restrictions, if any,
11 and in what form said petition should be granted. And
12 if any legislation is recommended said joint board is re-
13 quested to submit with its report a draft of an act or
14 acts embodying the legislation recommended.
