## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Nine.

### RESOLVE

To provide for the Completion of the Improvement of the Harbor of Cuttyhunk in the Town of Gosnold.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the  
2 treasury of the commonwealth the sum of ten thou-  
3 sand dollars, to be expended under the direction of the  
4 board of harbor and land commissioners in completing  
5 the improvement of the harbor of Cuttyhunk, in the  
6 town of Gosnold, by dredging the channel or in such  
7 other manner as said board may deem best. This sum  
8 to be in addition to the amounts heretofore authorized  
9 to be expended for said improvement: *provided*, that no  
10 money shall be expended unless the town of Gosnold  
11 shall pay into the treasury of the commonwealth the sum  
12 of five thousand dollars and secure land for a public  
13 landing place on the shores of said harbor.
