AN ACT REGULATING THE EMPLOYMENT OF PERSONS DURING A STRIKE, LOCKOUT OR OTHER LABOR TROUBLE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 149 of the General Laws is hereby amended
2 by inserting after section 23A, inserted by chapter 233
3 of the acts of 1934, the following section:—
4 *Section 23B.* No person, during the continuance of
5 a strike, lockout or other labor trouble among his em-
6 ployees, shall directly or indirectly employ any per-
7 son for the purpose of inflicting physical injury or in-
8 timidating said employees. Any person violating this
9 section shall be punished by a fine of not more than
10 one thousand dollars, or by imprisonment for not
11 more than one year, or both.

- 8 said employees. Any person violating this
- 9 section shall be punished by a fine of not more than
- 10 one thousand dollars, or by imprisonment for not
- 11 more than one year, or both.
