By Mr. Lally of Boston, petition of Bernard M. Lally that provision be made for the election of a board of assessors in the city of Boston and for appointment of deputy assessors and the selection of the chairman of said board. Cities.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ELECTION OF A BOARD OF ASSESSORS IN THE CITY OF BOSTON, FOR THE SELECTION OF ITS CHAIRMAN, AND FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF DEPUTY ASSESSORS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 93 of the Special Acts of 1918 is hereby
2 amended by striking out sections 2 and 3, as amended,
3 and inserting in place thereof the following sections:—

4 *Section 2.* The assessors shall be elected for two
5 year terms at every biennial election. The chairman,
6 who shall receive an annual salary of seventy-five
7 hundred dollars, shall be chosen by and from the
8 board; the other members of the board shall receive
9 an annual salary of six thousand dollars.

10 *Section 3.* The assessors may appoint such deputy
11 assessors as may be necessary, not exceeding five in
12 number. Each deputy assessor shall receive an annual
13 salary of five thousand dollars, and shall perform such
14 duties as the board may prescribe.
