

# HOUSE . . . No. 322

By Mr. Catino of Medford, petition of Michael Catino that the county of Middlesex be authorized to borrow money for the purpose of providing suitable accommodations for the District Court of Malden at Medford. Counties.

## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY OF MIDDLESEX TO BORROW MONEY FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING IN THE CITY OF MEDFORD SUITABLE ACCOMMODATIONS FOR THE DISTRICT COURT OF MALDEN.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The county commissioners of the  
2 county of Middlesex may acquire by purchase, or  
3 take by eminent domain under chapter seventy-nine  
4 of the General Laws, land for the purpose of con-  
5 structing thereon, in the city of Medford, a suitable  
6 building for the use of the district court of Malden,  
7 and may construct, originally equip and furnish said  
8 building. Said building when constructed may also  
9 serve the town of Arlington, said town of Arlington  
10 also being under the jurisdiction of the district court  
11 of Malden.

1 SECTION 2. For the purposes aforesaid, the county  
2 commissioners of said county may from time to time  
3 borrow upon the credit of the county such sums as  
4 may be necessary, not exceeding, in the aggregate,  
5 \_\_\_\_\_ dollars, and may issue  
6 bonds or notes of the county therefor. Each author-  
7 ized issue shall constitute a separate loan, and such  
8 loans shall be payable in not more than \_\_\_\_\_ years from  
9 their dates. Such bonds or notes shall be signed by  
10 the treasurer of the county and countersigned by a  
11 majority of the county commissioners. The county  
12 may sell the said securities at public or private sale  
13 upon such terms and conditions as the county com-  
14 missioners may deem proper, but not for less than  
15 their par value. Indebtedness incurred hereunder  
16 shall, except as herein provided, be subject to chapter  
17 thirty-five of the General Laws.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its ac-  
2 ceptance by the county commissioners of Middlesex  
3 county; provided, that such acceptance occurs prior  
4 to December thirty-first in the current year.
