AN ACT PROVIDING A PENSION FOR THE WIDOWS OF CERTAIN FIREMEN AND POLICE OFFICERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Upon the death of a police officer or a fireman who
2 was retired and receiving a pension under the pro-
3 visions of any general or special law, there shall be
4 paid to his widow a pension allowance in the same
5 amount as that paid to her deceased spouse at the
6 time of his death so long as she remains unmarried.
