AN ACT EXEMPTING THE CITY OF MEDFORD FROM PAYMENT OF EXCISE TAX ON GASOLINE AND OTHER MOTOR VEHICLE FUEL.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any provisions of chapter sixty-  
2 four A of the General Laws, no excise hereunder  
3 shall be payable on sales of fuel to the city of Medford.  
4 If such sale should be made directly by a distributor,  
5 no excise on account shall be payable by the dis-  
6 tributor under the provisions of section four of chapter  
7 sixty-four A of the General Laws. If such sale shall  
8 be made by a person other than a distributor the  
9 excise paid by the city of Medford shall be reimbursed  
10 to it in the same manner and under the same con-  
11 ditions as are set forth in section seven of said chapter  
12 sixty-four A.
